CTOR Awards in Translational Research

Translational research, when basic science is utilized for advancement of daily clinical treatment, has been the main engine of advances in Medicine. To promote the same concept in the field of dentistry, the Consortium for Translational Orthodontic Research (CTOR) located at NYU College of Dentistry, in collaboration with the AADR New York Section proposes a CTOR AWARD to the top 3 Dental students and 3 Post-Graduate students that attempt to advance patient care in clinical dentistry utilizing current scientific principles. Below are the guidelines for participating:

Eligibility

1. The applicant should be a Dental or Post-Graduate student.
2. Applicant should submit an abstract for poster presentation at the CTOR Symposium by emailing CTOR at info@orthodonticscientist.org. Please visit www.orthodonticscientist.org for abstract guidelines.
3. The Research of applicant utilizes a basic science model (in vitro, animal study or human study) to promote a clinical application in any discipline of clinical dentistry.
4. To revive and support the New York State section of American Association of Dental Research, applicant should be a student member of AADR New York State Section.

Participation in award competition

Abstracts that meet the criteria will be notified by Dr. Mani Alikhani, Director of CTOR, before August 31, 2017. Abstracts will be reviewed by independent referees for selection of top 3 posters in translational research in dentistry by a Dental student or Postgraduate Student. Students will present their posters at dedicated time to 3 Judges that will select the top 3 research projects in each category. Poster presentation to the Judges is mandatory and applicant cannot be absent during dedicated time of presentation. Time and location of presentation will be announced before the Symposium.

Awards

FIRST PLACE: \$500.00 check, CTOR Award Certificate, and Honoree CTOR Pin

SECOND PLACE: \$400.00 check, CTOR Award Certificate, and Honoree CTOR Pin

THIRD PLACE: \$300.00 check, CTOR Award Certificate, and Honoree CTOR Pin

Awards will be presented at the Symposium Reception.
