- Faculty Evaluation Report of student's pre-clinical assignments.
- Certificate of Attendance upon completion of the Mini-Residency program.

How to Apply

Eligibility Requirements

- Dental students and DDS/DMDs from
 - 1) dental schools accredited by the American or Canadian Dental Association or
 - 2) non-ADA accredited (international) dental schools that offer an equivalent to the US/Canadian dental degree.
- Demonstrate the ability to understand and communicate in English.

Application Instructions

- Complete the online Mini-Residency Application Form
- Submit 1 letter of recommendation (in English) from a professor who is familiar with your academic performance.
- Submit a 1-page personal statement expressing your interest in participating in this program and your expectations. Please also describe your pre-clinical and clinical Orthodontics experience in your current program.

Mini-Residency Accepted Participants

Accepted participants will receive an official Mini-Residency invitation letter as well as payment instructions by email. Participants may be required to obtain a tourist Visa at a US consulate in their country.

The acceptance letter can be used as an invitation letter to support your Visa application.

A non-refundable US \$1,000 tuition deposit is due by the date indicated in your acceptance letter.

Tuition and Fees

- US \$6,500 - Furnished Housing Option (single room)
- US \$6,000 - Furnished Housing Option (shared room)
- US \$5,000 - without Housing Option

The final tuition balance is due by June 30, 2018.
